What exactly is “Give 7” Enrichment?

“Give 7” for me lays the foundation for what I work daily to instill in my 5 children – respect. Teaching a child, from the youngest of age to greet someone with a five-fingered, two eyed hand shake sets the tone for the manners we expect.

Little SPORT is built upon a *A Golden Rule* work philosophy – we don’t offer a service or produce a product that we would not want for our own family and friends. The “Give 7” Enrichment program embodies so many elements I believe are important. Working to have children embrace learning early-through fun, play and great interaction is one of my most important!

For the “Give 7” program we have hired phenomenal, certified teachers with exceptional backgrounds ranging from advanced degrees, degrees in nutrition, Pre-school directing, but most importantly, all who have a LOVE of teaching our little ones!

The curriculum will incorporate a daily routine with standard, specifically replicated elements – Circle time greetings and songs, the Pledge of Allegiance (I’m a Patriot; I think the earlier the better!), learning the weather by “dressing” Edison our Elephant, songs reviewing the days of the week, giving thanks before eating (snack time), “Giving 7” before leaving at the end of the day...

Our buddy system will pair younger students with our older students (ie:2’s with our 3 & 4’s) during specific times. Buddies will not be siblings and will be used to create compassion towards one another, along with showing the “older” ones how to be a role model.

We will have monthly themes for our enrichment activities – the arts & craft projects, songs and stories will all align. Ages will be broken out for appropriate projects and learning. For independent “station” time we will also have creative toy and learning stations. Each class will also receive private play time in either the play Arena or Toot’s Training room, along with scheduled activities in the play Arena.

By creating an early childhood learning experience based on health, joy and respect we establish a strong base to build upon. These early years and experiences with classroom settings are so extremely important, we are excited to have the opportunity to inspire and enrich the lives of your little one!
